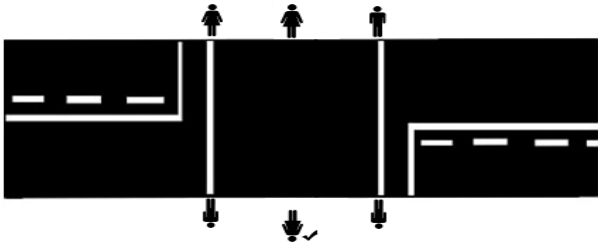
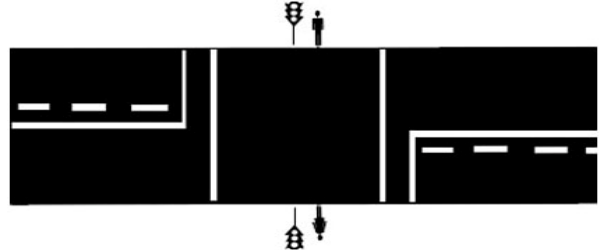


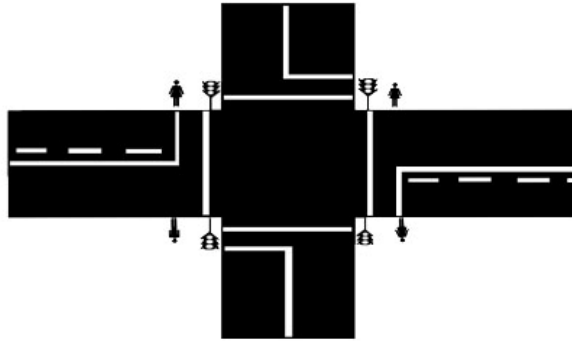

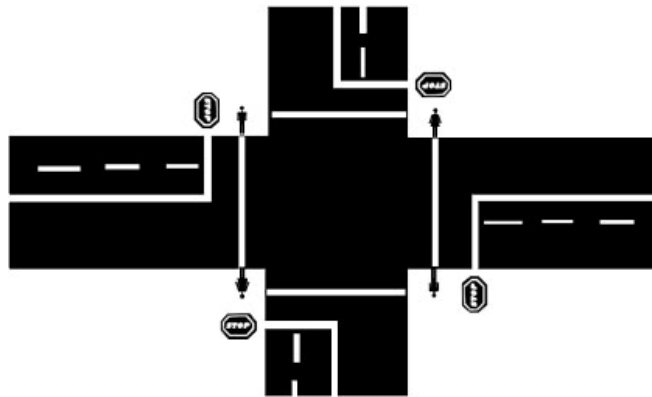
A. NORMAL STREET CROSSINGS FOR PEDESTRIANS
Captain - Leader - Member



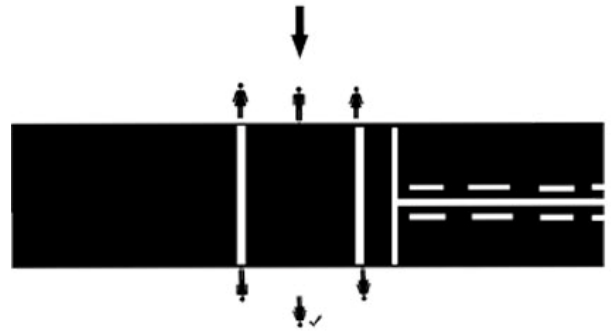
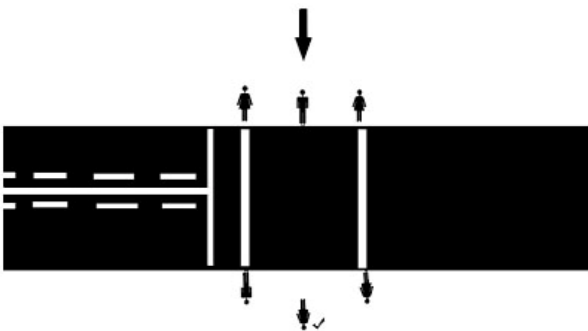
B. CONTROLLED PEDESTRIAN CROSSING
Robot manual control, no stop signs, whistles or warning signs



C. STREET CROSSING WITH TRAFFIC LIGHTS (As in B)
Every street to cross to be considered as a crossing.



D. STREET CROSSING AT STOP A AND B



E. DUAL ROAD WITH ONE OR MORE LANES DIVIDED BY A MEDIAN (Other combination as in C & D)
